Lozells Primary School Remote Learning Plan - Lockdown January 2021



Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you for your patience as our team of teachers and teaching assistants have worked hard to get remote online learning set up.

Our Remote Learning plan follows the guidance from the Department for Education which suggests schools have a combination of 'recorded lessons **OR** live lessons' along with 'time for pupils to complete tasks and assignments independently.' We will review our remote learning plan regularly and keep you updated. Your child's well-being is our priority, so we ask that children work through the activities as best they can and have regular breaks away from a device screen - perhaps to read a book, play a game, bake or go for a walk.

- Remind your children to use the chat on the Lozells Virtual classroom sensibly.
- Children must have regular breaks away from a device and regular exercise of 20 minutes daily.

Requesting a laptop for your child (one per family) or help with internet data costs

Weekly work packs/ work Books

In order to help children who do not have a device or who prefer to work on paper, teachers will be creating work packs weekly – these activities will cover the same learning as the online learning as much as possible, but with different activities for example.

Please notify the office if you wish to collect a pack.

To help children work more independently and also away from a screen, school will also be purchasing a series of age-related work books for some of the core subjects including the following: arithmetic, handwriting and reading comprehension for most year groups. Children will be given instructions on when to complete each page.

We hope parents can collect these from school this week - more information will follow.

What will remote learning look like for children with identified Special Educational Needs?

Our school SENDCO, Mrs Bond, will contact parents of children with an EHCP entitled to a school place or needing an individual remote learning schedule, lessons and resources. Where children would normally receive additional support from SEND agencies, Mrs Bond will plan for those to continue via Teams where appropriate and possible.

Marking and Feedback

Please help your child share their work with their class teacher by emailing photographs/work to the teacher's email or uploading completed Word/PDF documents to the Lozells Virtual Classroom in the 'Assignments' section or you can bring back a completed work pack for your child's teacher to mark.

It is expected that ALL children have an early start to their day and will start to complete the work set either online or in their work packs from 9:30am each day at the latest. Teaching staff will be supporting your child's engagement with their learning and may contact your child by phone to give them further specific support. Teachers will provide feedback on work for children individually, or to the class as a whole or quizzes may be marked automatically. We know that many parents are helping a number of their children and could be working themselves from home at the same time – we understand this and ask that children try to complete the English and Maths activities first.
