## Topics we will be learning about...

### *Summer 2: Ticket to ride & celebrating magical me!*

After the May half-term holidays, our focus will be preparing ourselves for the transition into Reception. We will be sharing stories all about travelling to new and exciting destinations.

Books we will be reading: Mr Gumpy's Outing & Whatever Next.

### *Maths – Stop at 1, 2, 3, 4, 5*

This half term, children will continue to build on counting skills introduced in previous blocks. Children's understanding of the cardinal principle will be extended, as children count out up to 5 objects from a larger group.

The children will also be exploring the 'order irrelevance principle'. This is the understanding that the order in which we count a set doesn't matter. We will explore this by counting objects in a line from left to right and then right to left and prompt children to notice the total is still the same.



Just a quick reminder to please check the weather each day and dress your child appropriately for nursery.

Whether it's sun hats and sun cream for warm days or coats and jumpers for cooler ones, being prepared helps keep everyone comfortable and safe!

Please also remember to send your child to nursery with a water bottle!
